




## **ITALY**





## Research Streams & methodology: Italy

### 1. PREVENTION & PROTECTION SYSTEM in the Veneto Region Apr. 2019 – Dec. 2020

- => Ethnographic observation (12 months, +300 day-sessions within the N.A.Ve project)
- => Interviews (46 stakeholders; 16 beneficiaries) + analysis of some case-files
